Travel from Auxonne to Cusey

Saone River/Champagne-Burgundy Canal

Beautiful rural France awaits you as Prosperité takes you on a cruise from Auxonne, on the River Saone to the Champagne-Burgundy canal Sit back and see the peaceful, quaint villages pass by as Grand Cru Meanders its way along this charming waterway, one of the last to be completed in 1907. The Champagne-Burgundy canal connects the Marne and Saone rivers and, indeed, two of France's most iconic regions, Champagne and Burgundy.



SUNDAY: Welcome Aboard

Travel: Arrival at Auxonne Meals: Dinner onboard

In the afternoon, our driver will greet you at the designated meeting point. Relax in our transfer vehicle to Prosperite, moored in Auxonne on the River Saone. The Champagne-Burgundy Canal connects two of France's most iconic regions. Our route offers sublime cruising in the heart of rural France as well as excursions to important sights in nearby Burgundy. Enjoy a traditional champagne welcome and introduction to Prosperite and her crew before your first of many gourmet dinners on board.

MONDAY: Enchanting Medieval Village

Travel: Auxonne to Potailleur-sur-Saone Meals: Breakfast, lunch, & dinner onboard

Prosperite cruises this morning on the River Saone. As your world slows down, there's time to notice small things: the aroma of freshly baked bread drifting from town or the flash of sunlight on tiled roofs. This afternoon, your Tour Guide introduces the Medieval village of Beze, criss-crossed by canals and waterways. With its ancient riverside residences and picturesque wash houses, Beze is one of France's most photogenic villages. Discover the Grottes (caves) and remains of the Abbey before returning to Prosperite for drinks and dinner onboard.

TUESDAY: Destination Dijon

Travel: Pontailier sur Saone to the village of Cheuge Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner onboard

This morning, Dijon offers a pleasurable assault on the senses. Preserved palaces and beautiful churches, recalling the reign of the Dukes of Burgundy, vie for attention with specialty boutiques, small cafes, and serene gardens. Shop, sip, and stroll your way through this small city brimming with authentic French life. Return as Prosperite slips onto the peaceful Champagne-Burgundy Canal. Chef has been busy creating tonight's epicurean dinner to be enjoyed onboard.

WEDNESDAY: A Day in Burgundy Wine Country

Travel: Village of Cheuge Meals: Breakfast & dinner onboard, lunch ashore

With your Tour Guide, encounter the best of Burgundy's wine country. Starting in Beaune, where millions of bottles are still stored under cobblestoned streets, take a tour of the Hospice de Beaune, an immaculately preserved Medieval hospital. After a winetasting, it's on to luncheon at Hostellerie du Levernois, followed by a tour and tasting of Domaine Patriache. Since 1780, this Domaine has been making wines with exceptionally pampered grapes, reflecting the historic bounty of Burgundian soil. Return to the Prosperite for this evening's dinner party onboard, and then what about digestifs in the hot tub while lazing under the stars?

THURSDAY: Meet a Chateau Owner?

Travel: Cheuge to Pouilly-sur-Vingeanne Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner onboard

This morning, as Prosperite continues to cruise, relax on deck or explore the towpath and country lanes by bicycle. This afternoon, our Tour Guide introduces Chateau de Rosières. This fascinating castle, located just a few minutes from the canal, dates from 1321. Meet owner Bertrand Bergerot, who, with his youthful family, is restoring the castle and grounds; he'll share his passion for Medieval architecture. Back on board, enjoy cocktails and a chef-driven dinner menu.

FRIDAY: You've Tasted the Wine – Now Taste the Cheese!

Travel: Pouilly sur Vingeanne to Cusey Meals: Breakfast, lunch & dinner aboard

After a morning cruise, our Tour Guide chauffeurs you to Ferme de Montsaugéon. This farm produces goats milk cheese amongst other regional produce. Meet the adorable goats and their charismatic owner Valérie for a demonstration of the cheese making process, a cheese tasting, and her insights into local life. Back onboard, Chef is creating a candlelit multi-course Farewell Feast, ending your cruise in style.

SATURDAY: A Sad Farewell

Travel: Transfer from Cusey Meals: Breakfast onboard

After breakfast, you will be chauffeured to the designated drop off point.
